10 COMMITTEEOPERATINGUIDELINES

The Board has the power to appoint the Committees it considers necessary and advisable.

The provisions below set out the operating guidelines applicable to all standing Committees, unless otherwise expresslprovided for in a Committee's terms of reference.

The Board magalsofrom time to time establish task forces, advisory committees or other temporary working groups to address time limited projects.

10.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of Board Committees is to provide the purpose of Board responsibility and to help the Board carry out its work.

10.2 MANDATE

EachCommittee reviews its own terms of reference annual and submits any proposed changes to the Governance Committee for review and recommendation approval to the Board.
